Future Teacher Internship

Have you thought about becoming a teacher?

Senior year, volunteer during 2 MHS Periods with a mentor teacher gaining experience with learners in the content area / age of interest to YOU! In this class, interns have worked with their mentor teacher to plan + teach mini lessons, assist with remediation, participate in field trips, + more. <u>Benefits of this course include building your resume, networking with professionals, + documenting skills learned on the State Certified Youth Leadership Portfolio.</u>

In this 1 credit course, interns will also learn about school of education admission requirements, collaborate with other interns, discover professional organizations and professional learning communities, + become familiar with the WI Educator Standards.

Careers with Kids is highly recommended during junior year.

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Sports Medicine Internship

Volunteer as an Athletic Training Student Aide with a Licensed Athletic Trainer (LAT) for 60 hours at games and practices. In the training room, aides will learn skills needed to assist the LAT in caring for injured athletes + as directed by the LAT monitor rehabilitation exercises, prepare medical kits, review / maintain medical records + more.

Before you enroll in this 0.5 credit course:

- Students in grades 9-11 should talk with your parent / guardian, then complete / return the application to Mrs. Fredrick (applications available on the MHS CTE webpage + in the school counseling office)
- 2. Mid-May, interview with course teacher + LAT
- Once accepted, officially register for the course, + begin volunteer experience during football season
