DC Work-Based Learning I

- 1.5 credits
 - 0.5 Face-to-Face / Online Instruction (students must opt-in to earn DC, if available)
 - 1.0 + Work Experience
 - Average 10 hours / week or more, paycheck
 - Up to 2 periods / semester for School-to-Work Release (may be revoked at quarter if "F / I" grade in any course)
- Course Topics
 - Employability Skills
 - o Resumes + Cover Letters
 - Interviewing Skills
 - Career Exploration
 - Post-Secondary Options
 - Health + Safety @ Work
- Pre-Regs
 - Earned 14+ required credits
 - Earned 6+ elective credits
 - Approved employment with an area employer
 - Good standing at MHS

Work-Based Learning II

- 1.5 credits
 - o 0.5 Face-to-Face / Online Instruction
 - 1.0 + Work Experience
 - Average 10 hours / week or more, paycheck
 - Up to 2 periods / semester for School-to-Work Release (may be revoked at quarter if "F / I" grade in any course)
- Course Topics
 - o Employability Skills
 - Teamwork + Leadership
 - o Adapting to Change
 - o Entrepreneurship
 - Money + Insurance
 - Work-Life Balance
- Pre-Regs
 - Successful completion of Work-Based Learning I is highly recommended, but not required
 - Pre-Reqs from DC Work-Based Learning I
