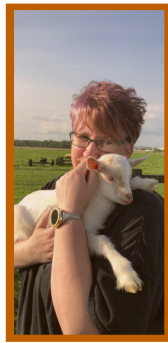


The **NASONVILLE HOLIDAY SHOP** is coming soon!

What is the Nasonville Holiday Shop?

The gym will be transformed into a "store" in which students can do their holiday shopping for their family! Students can bring small amounts of money and a list of family members they would like to shop for, to school. Blank lists will be sent home with students prior to shopping. Items in the shop range in price from \$0.25 to \$5.00. All items are donated! After students purchase the items, volunteers will wrap the gifts purchased for mom and dad for students in grades K-3. Goodies for other family members will be placed in a bag to be wrapped at home and put under the tree. Students in grades 4-6 will have all gifts placed in a bag to be wrapped. The items your child purchased will be sent to their classrooms to take home before winter break.

How can YOU help?

1. Donate items for our sale!

We are in need of things to sell to the students! These items do not need to be new; gently used is okay. We will accept: board games, stuffed animals, toys, pictures, picture frames, candles, books, knick knacks, dishes, tools (not sharp), household items, etc. In years past, we've been very short on men's gifts, so those would be helpful to have! We will NOT accept: movies, video games, make-up, fingernail polish, clothing (hats, scarves, and gloves are allowed), dangerous items, or items with logos for alcohol, tobacco, or inappropriate sayings. **Please bring items to the office. We are accepting donations from December 12th until December 15th.** Any items that are not sold by the end of the sale will be donated.

2. Donate paper bags, holiday gift bags, tags, tape, and/or wrapping paper!

3. Help with sales and wrapping!

We need adults to help students go through the shopping process, collect money, and wrap gifts. This will all happen during school day hours on December 16th and 19th.
