Can I use these apps at home?

Yes! You can use your district credentials on a personal or school device to log into SDOM approved digital resources at home.

For Example:

- Canvas
- Googles apps for education
- Imagine Math Facts (Big Brainz)
- ThinkCentral

My family is using a personal device at home, how do we download these apps?

To download apps from the App Store you will need an Apple ID. District emails/credentials are not available for use to create apple ID's. An Apple ID must be a parent/guardian personal email, or if the student is 13+ years old, they may use their own personal email. After you create your Apple ID, student's can use their credentials to log in to apps they use at school.
