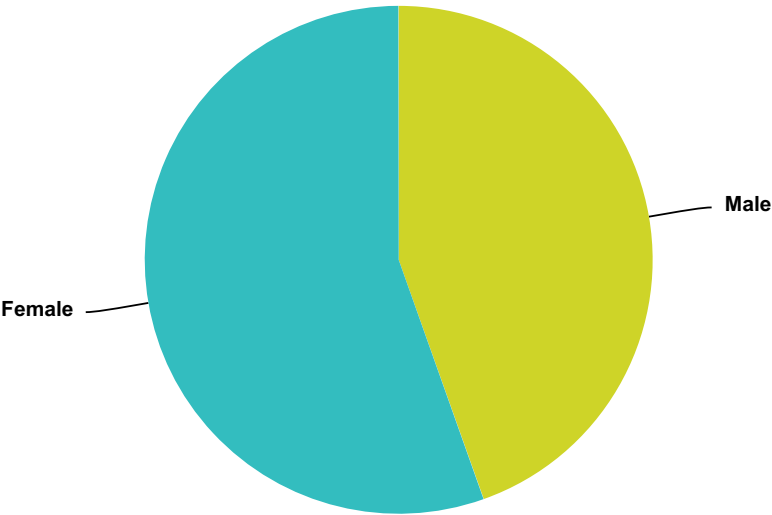

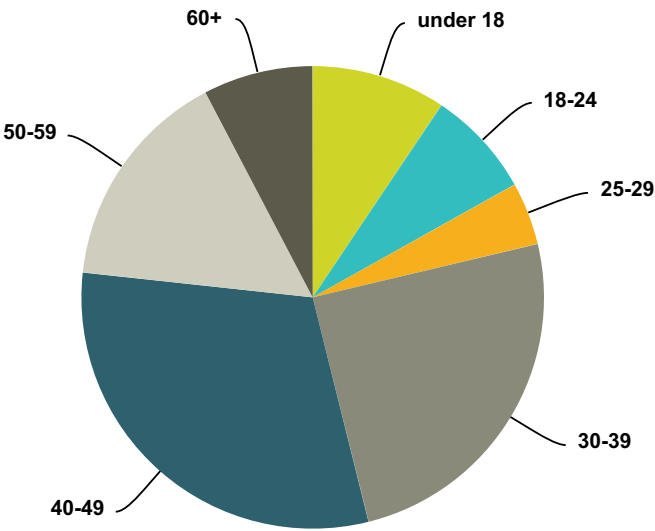

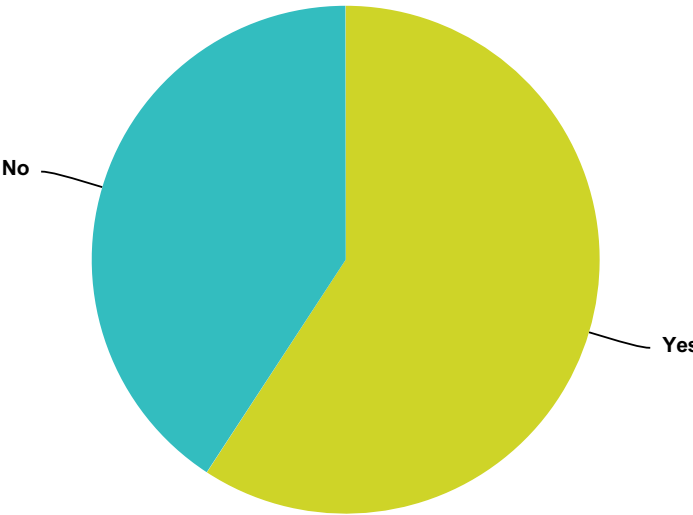

Q3 Do you have school-aged children (3-18)?

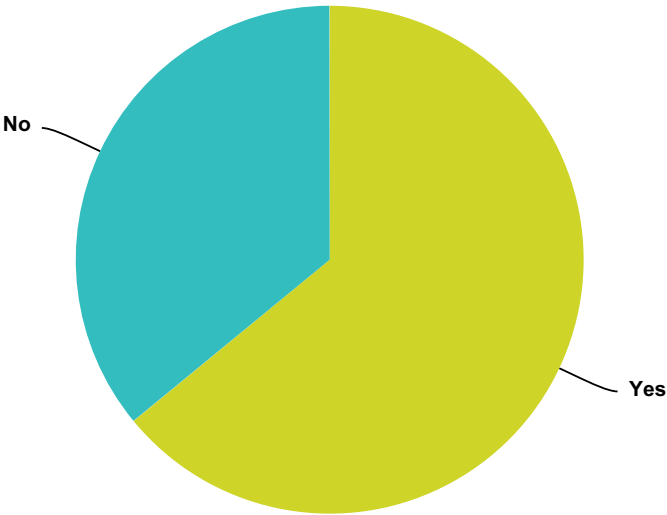

Q4 Do your children currently attend, or plan to attend, Marshfield's public schools?

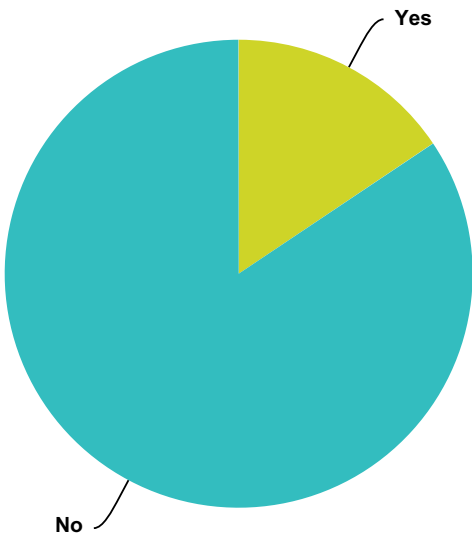

Q5 Are you an employee of the School District of Marshfield?

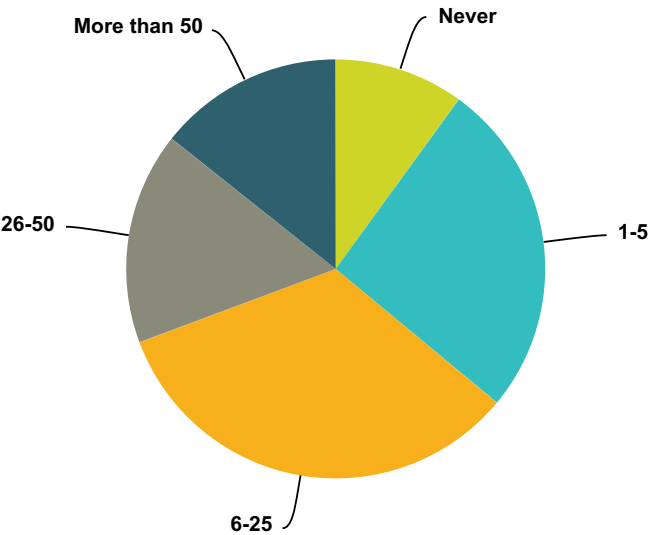

Q6 How many times per year do you use or attend an event at the athletic facilities (indoor or outdoor) at Marshfield High School or Middle School?

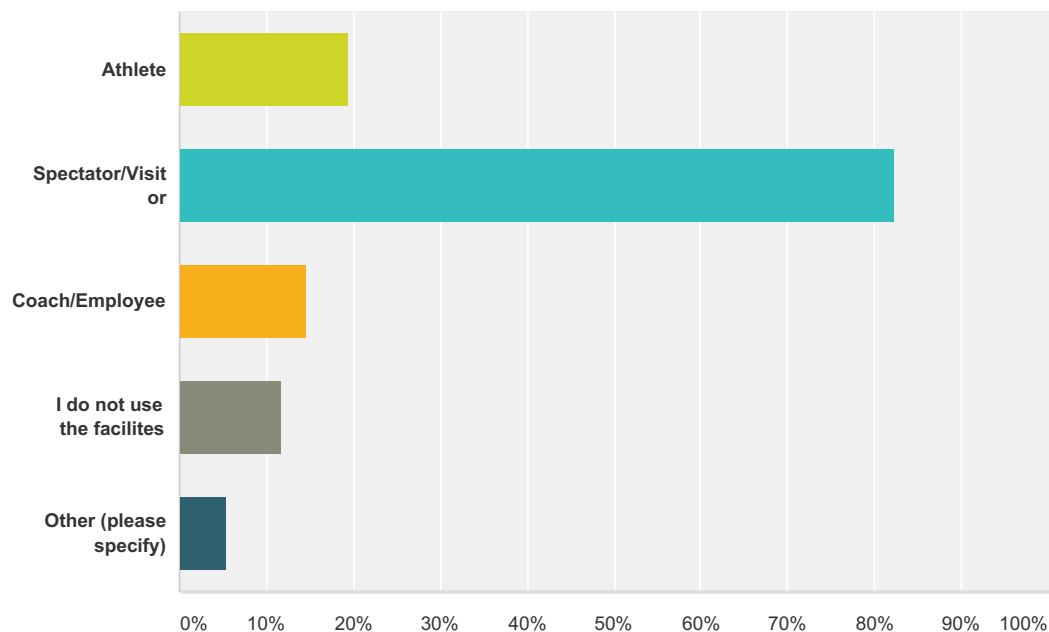

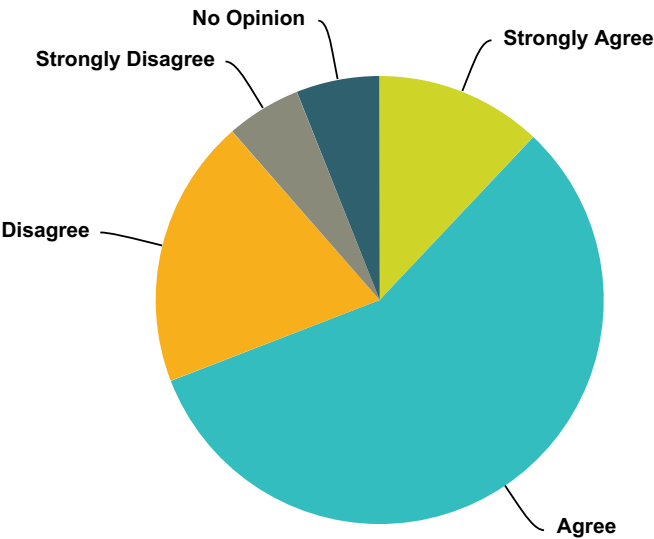

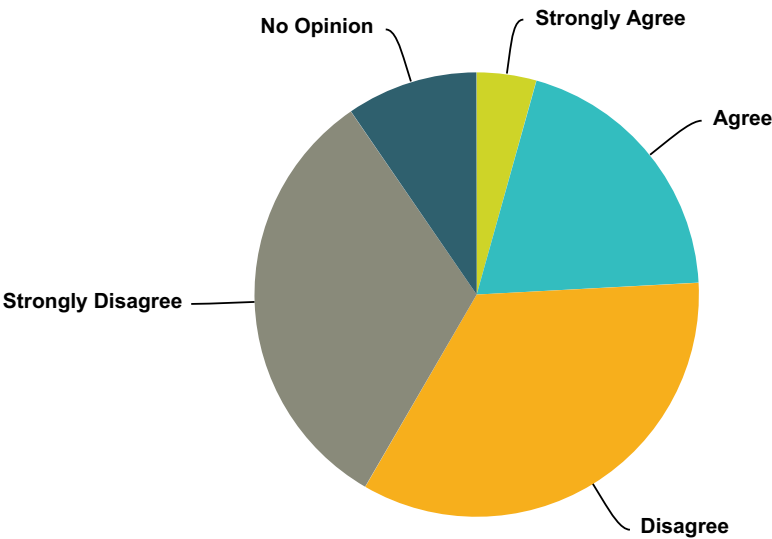

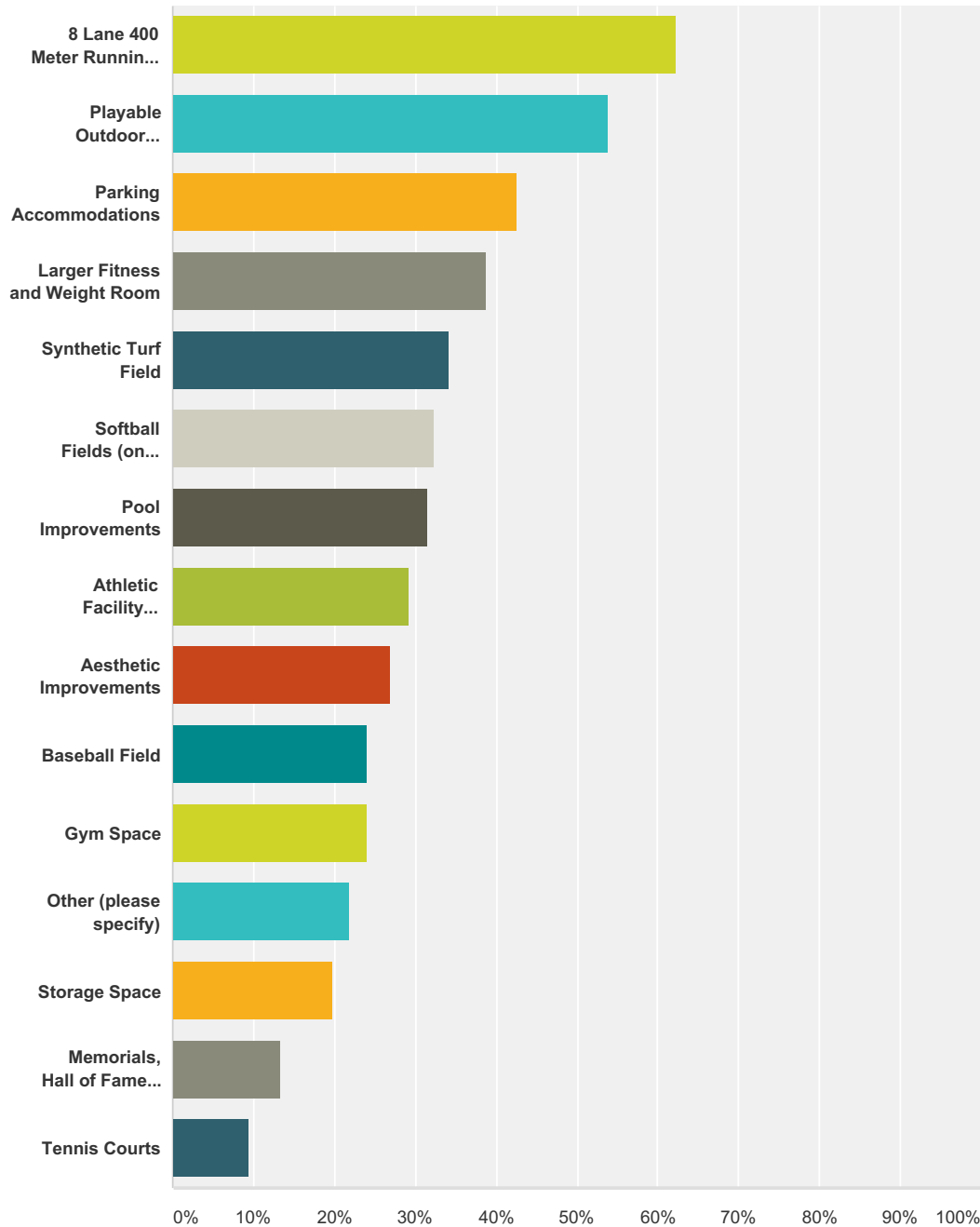
