Now that the 2019-2020 school year has concluded, we want to thank all of you for your patience, efforts, and understanding during this time. It truly is one to remember. A few notes moving forward into the summer that we would like to pass along:

- An email was sent earlier today with summer school information, including information about iPads, please refer to that email if your student is taking summer school or still wishes to enroll in summer school. We still have openings in Sports Medicine I, Tailor Made Math, Psychology R, Crime, Justice & Law R and Tigers on the Prowl.
- We will send information along throughout the summer regarding summer school, fall registration, sports, and what the beginning of the year may look like.
