Marshfield High School Dance Policies

- Semi-formal Attire – No caps/head coverings or backpacks allowed
- Formal Attire is preferred - No caps/head coverings or backpacks allowed
- Only high school students can attend an MHS dance; a guest of an MHS student can only be 1 year removed from high school and must have administrative approval to attend. No middle school students may attend MHS dances.
- Each student must present their student ID at time of admittance, this includes guests. Guests who do not have a student ID will be required to present a picture ID or driver's license.
- No swearing, profanity, or behavior that instigates criminal damage to property will be tolerated.
- Students who bring guests from other districts should have the proper approval form on file at time of admittance for each dance.
- All Court music along with DJ's choice of music must not contain lyrics with inappropriate sexual, drug, violence, racial or profane content in them.
- All Dances begin at 7:00 pm and conclude no later than 11:00 pm. Students can enter at 6:45 pm and need to leave immediately following conclusion of dance at 11:00 pm
- Police liaison officers will be present at all dances at MHS.
- Members of Court for any MHS Dance must meet the following academic and behavioral standards:
 - a. No discipline referrals for the current school year
 - b. No classroom ejections for the current school year
 - c. No truancy issues
 - d. GPA of 2.25 or better and no failing grades or current missing assignments for current school year
 - e. No Athletic Code violations
 - f. No municipal citations (traffic violations other than disorderly conduct will not be considered)
