Student Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

Door will not open to Marshfield Middle School until 7:30am each morning. Bus riders will enter Door 3, and students who are dropped off, walk, or ride bikes will enter through Door 2. Upon entry, students will be required to hand sanitize and report directly to 1st hour. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 to 7:42am. Please remember that 1st hour starts at 7:45am.

Dismissal will occur in 3 phases with one-third of our students being dismissed at one time in order to promote physical distancing. The first wave will start at 2:44, the next at 2:47, and the last at 2:50pm. Please be aware of this as you may see students start to leave the building a little earlier than our last bell that rings at 2:50pm.

Backpack Expectations

Due to safety concerns with COVID-19, lockers will not be used for this school year. Instead, students will be allowed to carry a backpack with them from class to class. School items ONLY should be in backpacks. This includes school supplies, assignment notebook, charged iPad, lunch, and a turned off cell phone. Administration reserves the right to search backpacks as situations arise.
