No Smoking


Please remember that there is no smoking on any Marshfield School District property, this includes cars. Our campuses are smoke free. Please refrain from smoking in your cars and on school grounds.

Growth Mindset Monthly News

January: Feedback is a Gift

In January, we will focus on giving process praise, critique, feedback and specific praise versus person praise, critique, feedback or vague praise. "The right kind of feedback and praise can be a powerful motivator for reinforcing the growth mindset and the value of effort and perseverance, but the wrong kind of praise and feedback can send students spiraling into their fixed mindsets (Brock & Hundley, 2016, p. 116)
