iPads, Library Books, & Student Belongings

If your student is signed up for virtual summer school, you may keep the iPad. **If you have a charger, please bring that back when you return the device.** Similar to all of our pick-ups the last few weeks, you will drive up to the front of the school and someone will come out to collect your device, you do not need to leave the vehicle. People will not be allowed into the school at this time due to the continued school closure. You do not need to call us when you are coming, you can come anytime during the window.

Click on all areas you would like to verify or update. Be sure to click Save at the bottom of each screen that you are submitting changes for. If no changes are needed, no further action is needed. All students will be considered as returning in the fall. If you will not be returning to the School District of Marshfield in September, please notify us of the city, state, and school where you will be moving through the Family Access Contact Us tab in the upper right corner or through your school office as soon as you know. An email will be sent in August regarding back to school information.

SUMMER WELLNESS REMINDERS

Summer is an excellent time to schedule well child visits with your child's doctor or other medical provider. Although individuals may be hesitant to seek medical care at this time, local clinics have practices in place to ensure patient & family safety. Many clinics have set aside special areas strictly for visits such as well child checks & all visitors are screened.

Please keep in mind that Wisconsin law requires several immunizations for all students entering kindergarten & a Tdap booster for those entering 6th grade. Summer is an excellent time to obtain any immunizations your child may need. You can contact your medical provider's office to determine which vaccines your child should have & to schedule immunization appointments.

Please note school district policy requires a new medication permission form to be completed each year. If your child needs medication to be administered at school during 2020-2021 please provide an updated form to your school office.
