# AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES

The mission of Agriculture & Natural Resources is to prepare students for careers in the agriculture industry, support students in their career choices, and develop leadership skills in students to benefit their community.

### CAREER AND TECHNICAL STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

A CTSO is a quality component of career and technical education programs that support and enhance related school-based and work-based learning. They provide value to students through various opportunities that allow them to showcase their skills and knowledge.

### **POST-SECONDARY CREDIT COURSES**

To earn Dual Credit, students enroll in approved courses, demonstrate knowledge and skills using Mid-State Technical College (MSTC) textbooks, tests, etc. A letter grade is posted on an official MSTC transcript and counted towards MSTC's grade point average. The following dual credit courses are offered in the Agriculture department:

- DC Horticulture
- DC Forestry AND DC Wildlife Management
- DC Animal Management AND DC Dairy Science

## **EQUIVALENCY SCIENCE CREDIT COURSES**

Students have the opportunity to earn Science credit by completing Agriculture classes! A MAXIMUM OF 1 CREDIT of science may be obtained from the following agriculture classes:

- ES Animal Science 1/2 Science credit
- ES Biotechnology 1/2 Science credit
- ES Plant & Soil Science ½ Science credit
- ES Plants, Animals and You 1 Science credit

You must take **BOTH** of the courses listed below to earn ½ Science credit:

- Dairy Science
- Small Animal Veterinary Science

- Our FFA chapter is the most active student organization with trips, competitions, and leadership opportunities year round.
