Gameday provides students with a rare opportunity for hands-on experiences designing and producing digital media utilizing the same technologies used at Camp Randall, Lambeau Field, and other live event venues. ## POST SECONDARY CREDIT COURSES

To earn Dual Credit, students enroll in approved courses, demonstrate knowledge and skills using Mid-State Technical College (MSTC) textbooks, tests, etc. A letter grade is posted on an official MSTC transcript and counted towards MSTC's grade point average. The following Business & Information Technology courses are offered for Dual Credit:

- DC Business Core
- DC BIT Capstone

Advanced Placement courses allow students to earn college credit based on the score of a test given at the completion of the course. The following courses are offered for Advanced Placement credit in the Business & Information Technology department:

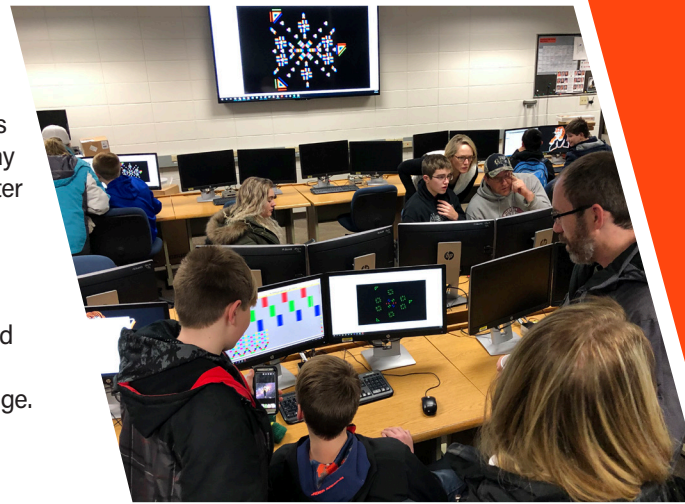
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## DID YOU KNOW?

- We house one of the leading Certiport Testing Centers in the entire state of Wisconsin. Students can **earn globally recognized industry certifications** in Microsoft Office, Adobe digital-media software, and Unity Programmer and VR Developer certifications.
- MHS has had **multiple national qualifiers** for the Microsoft Office Specialist World Championships!
- In 2020, a Marshfield FBLA Chapter member placed **Top 10 in the nation** in the Coding & Programming Event at the FBLA National Competition.
- Youth Service Learning (YSL): Students who **volunteer 100 hours** by the time they graduate receive recognition on their transcript and earn the **President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA)**.
- The Finance and Investment Challenge Bowl® (FICB) is a financial literacy program for high school students. MHS has advanced to the State Tournament four times—three times in the last four years—**winning the State Championship in 2018-19**.
- **The Tiger Stadium Store is managed by the B&IT Capstone class.** Students develop skills in inventory management, accounting, sales, marketing, and customer service. It's a valuable opportunity for students to experience all aspects of running a business.
