# 2. Review June Minutes and Action Items

- Led to a discussion about Grant E.S. treat-based celebration survey
  - The majority of respondents did not feel treat-based celebrations were excessive and were not in favor of a policy. The group discussed ways to initiate a wellness initiative at Grant. Ideas included: inviting other teachers to attend school wellness committee meetings, presenting about school wellness at a staff meeting (3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month at 3pm), and approaching the school nurse to learn more about dental/blood sugar issues in Grant students.

# 3. Farm to School Update

- Great Lakes Great Apple Crunch takes place on October 12. Apples are being provided by Rock Ridge Orchard, and there will be enough apples for all students including cold lunch students. **Action**: George will make a Facebook post to promote the event.

- 4. Walk to School Day & Walk/Bike to School Challenge
  - Walk to School Day banners have been distributed to each participating school.
