Below are a few PBIS reminders for December.

**PBIS PAWS:** Your Student(s) may have mentioned that their class has been working to earn PAWS. PAWS are given to classes that are being safe, responsible, and respectful. When classes receive a PAW they are displaying them outside their classroom door. This is in conjunction with our PBIS implementation.  
(Positive Behavior Intervention Supports)

**PBIS Tiger Tokens:** Tiger Tokens are individual PBIS rewards that are given to individual students for being safe, responsible, and respectful. Students get to save their Tiger Tokens to buy items from the school store.

**Attendance:** Every students' attendance is important! Students need to be in school as much as possible to ensure maximum learning opportunities. When students are gone more than 10 days they are considered habitually truant. As a point of reference, parents and students should make every attempt not to miss more than 2 days of school per quarter.
